### **WATER EFFICIENCY PROGRAM AVAILABLE TO CITY OF SEDONA RESTAURANTS AND FOOD SERVICE INDUSTRY**

The City of Sedona is pleased to announce a water efficiency program for the food service industry. The program, called the Arizona Rinse Smart, consists of a pre-rinse spray valve retrofit system. The high velocity valves are designed to save water by more effectively removing food particles from dishes before they are placed in a commercial dishwasher. The valves install in a matter of minutes.

Approximately two-thirds of the water used in a restaurant is used to wash dishes. The new Rinse Smart spray valves not only use less water, they clean better and save energy. Results of the Smart Rinse program show a medium-sized restaurant can save an average of 50,000 gallons of water per year with this program, saving not only money but conserving a very precious natural resource.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources and the Bureau of Reclamation have funded this exciting water saving program. The Arizona Smart Rinse program is free to all restaurant owners or food service businesses with a valid City of Sedona Business License.
