Promotional Sign (banner)

Each Promotional Sign Permit shall be valid for a maximum of ten (10) consecutive days and shall not exceed 20 square feet of word copy. Each business shall be allowed four (4) Promotional Sign Permits per calendar year. (\$25.00 per 10 days).

Grand Opening/Going Out of Business

Each Grand Opening or Going Out of Business Sign Permit shall be valid for a maximum of thirty (30) consecutive days and shall not exceed 20 square feet of word copy. Each business shall be allowed one (1) Grand Opening and one (1) Going Out of Business sign permit. (\$25.00)

Language to be included on the sign:

- All temporary signs shall be located on the business premises that directly relate to the purpose of the sign. Off-premise signs are not allowed.
- All temporary signs shall not be located within street or highway right-of-ways.
- Flags, balloons, and costumed characters are allowed for the duration of the permit.
- Temporary signs are to be located in commercial zoning districts only.
- State law requires that you call for a Blue Stake inspection a minimum of 2 days prior to any digging into the ground for any purpose. A Blue Stake inspection requires that any utilities with underground lines mark the location of their lines to prevent disruption during digging/excavation activities. IMPORTANT –

The permittee shall indemnify, defend, and save harmless the City of Sedona from any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, proceedings, loss, cost, and damages of every kind and description, including attorneys' fees and/or litigation expenses, which may be brought or made or incurred by the City of Sedona on account of loss of or damage to any property or for injuries or death of any person, caused by, arising out of, or contributed to, in whole or in part, by reason of any act, omission, professional error, fault, mistake, or negligence of permittee, its employees, agents, or representatives, or subcontractors, their employees, agents, or representatives in connection with or incident to the performance of this agreement, or arising out of Worker's Compensation claims, Unemployment Compensation claims, or Unemployment Disability Compensation claims of employees of permittee and/or its subcontractors or claims under similar such laws and obligations. Permittees' obligation under this Section shall not extend to any liability caused by the sole negligence of the City of Sedona or its employees.
