

Construction begins Monday, Sept. 11



Park will close on Sept. 11.



Construction is expected to last about 60 days.



The park is expected to reopen on or before Nov. 11.

Construction will also affect a small portion of the Sunrise Trail near the southern end of the park, and trail traffic will be rerouted to ensure hiker safety.

What's coming. \$228,548 in improvements.

- Grading and installation of catch basins to address water runoff and drainage issues.
- Entrance, walkway and fencing improvements.
- A new dog play area with artificial turf and decomposed granite.
- New drinking fountains and hose bibs for pet watering in both the small and large dog areas.
- Addition of eight new off-street parking spaces, two of them accessible.
