Posse Grounds RED DIRT CONCERT series

Welcome to Sedona, a city ANIMATED by the Arts! We support local musicians through our Red Dirt concert series and look forward to working with you.

Red Dirt concerts are structured as follows: One Opening Act performing for 20 minutes. One Headliner performing for 90 minutes. An amateur act may be inserted between these two primary acts if appropriate.

Please check each box you are interested in.

Opening Act may be a performer of nearly any kind: musician, poet, dancer, comedian, storyteller, magician, etc. Opening Act will be considered based on compatibility with the Headliner for that concert date. Opening Act is paid \$135 for the night's performance.

Headliner may be a band or performance group able to keep an audience engaged for 90 minutes. A short break (of up to five minutes) is sometimes appropriate and can be discussed. Headliner is paid \$400 for the night's performance.

Amateur Act may perform for ten to twelve minutes in-between the opening act and headliner. This opportunity does not receive payment but does get the chance to perform on stage!
