Household Hazardous Waste Program

What is Household Hazardous Waste?

A "household hazardous waste" or "HHW" is a used or leftover consumer product that contains toxic, reactive, ignitable or corrosive ingredients. "HHW" items are typically labeled: **Acid, Caution, Danger, Flammable, Poison, Toxic** and **Warning**.



Who can use the program & how much does it cost for disposal?

This program is **FREE** to residents of the City of Flagstaff, the City of Sedona and Coconino County. Flagstaff city residents must bring a valid state ID and a current water bill. Coconino County residents must bring a valid state ID. City of Sedona residents must bring a valid state ID and a current utility bill.

When is the HPC open?

Wednesday and Fridays, 9am-3pm
Saturdays, 8am-2pm

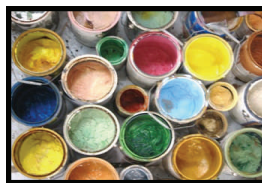
Directions to HPC:

From Flagstaff, drive north on Hwy 89 five miles past the Mall. Continue past Silver Saddle Road 1 mile. Look for the green city sign on the right. Turn right onto Landfill road and continue to the end of Landfill Road.

Participation Guidelines

Accepted wastes:

- **Automotive Products**
Antifreeze, Batteries, Brake/PS and Transmission Fluid, Gas, Lubricants, Oil (new, used & filters) and Waxes
- **Consumer Products**
Adhesives, Aerosols, Batteries, Camp Stove Propane Canisters, Cleaners, Detergents, Mercury Thermostats and Thermometers, Nail Products, Photo Chemicals and Spa/Pool Products
- **Gardening Products**
Fertilizers, Fungicides, Herbicides, Insecticides, Pesticides and Poisons
- **Painting Products**
Additives, Latex & Oil Paint, Putty, Shellac, Solvents, Spray Paints, Stains, Thinners and Varnishes
- **Batteries**
Alkaline, Automotive, Button, Cell Phone (Ni-Cd and Ni-Mh) and Lithium Ion/Lithium
- **Electronics**
Cell Phones, Computers, Disks, DVD Players, Faxes, Monitors, Peripherals, Printers, Stereos, Televisions & VCRs
- **Fluorescent Light Bulbs/Ballasts**
Unbroken CFLs, Fluorescent, UV & Incandescent bulbs and Ballasts
- Please Note: There are limits for the amount of each waste type that can be accepted and waste must be in 5 gallon containers or smaller



Participation Guidelines

Unacceptable wastes:

Ammunition, Asbestos Materials, Bio-hazardous waste, Broken Fluorescent Bulbs, Compressed Gases, Explosives, Flares, General Trash and Recyclables, Mixed Waste, Radioactive Materials, Sharps/Medical Waste, Tires, Unknown Chemicals and Unidentified Wastes. Hazardous waste in containers larger than a 5 gallon bucket will NOT be accepted

Drop and Swap Program



The Drop and Swap area of the HPC contains **FREE** reusable products. Stock varies daily. Although drop and swap has no set limitations, please be considerate of others. This program is to encourage the reuse, reduction & recycling of household hazardous waste.
