rake (Agg You	ER THIS PERMIT YOU ARE ALLOWED: To maintain your existing driveway access. You may and level out your driveway, repair or fill in any potholes or ruts. Import or export gravel or ABC regate Base Course) material, to match existing, as long as the grade elevation is not changed. may maintain your visibility triangles for sight distance on the frontage of your property within side property lines, as long as all the material is hauled away.




Figure 9-43, Visibility Triangle

Land Development Code, Article 9

910.09 Sight Distance.

- A. To ensure that landscape materials do not constitute a driving hazard, no landscaping higher than 3 feet at maturity or fencing higher than 3 feet shall be placed within the visibility triangles.
- 1. To determine the visibility triangles necessary for a corner lot, measure 30 feet back along lot lines from the point of intersection of the 2 lot lines.
- 2. At drive entrances, measure 10 feet back along drive and lot line from the point of intersection of drive and lot line.
- B. Existing vegetation is permitted within a visibility triangle if foliage is pruned and maintained at a height under 3-feet or above 6 feet measured from the lowest branch, to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
