The quantities in the bid schedule are the approximate lengths of stripe to be painted or approximate number of preformed items to be installed. Quantities are for bid comparison purposes. At the City's sole discretion quantities may be changed for the actual performance of work. The striping on SR 89A and SR 179, including roundabouts, will be scheduled for twice per year. Unit prices are valid so long as the actual quantities are within 20% of the quantities in the bid schedule.

D. SPECIFICATIONS

9. The work areas are the City streets listed on the attached striping list. Not all areas will be striped with each striping assignment. The scope of each assignment shall be considered a mobilization and shall be assigned by City Maintenance Superintendent. While subject to change at the City's sole discretion the City currently anticipates that all streets on the list will be striped at least once per year and all markings will be refreshed once per year, Subject to change at the City's sole discretion the bike lane striping and bike symbol marking along SR 179 and 89A will be performed twice during the year.
10. Where lines are wider than 4", such as turn lanes, they shall be paid for using the 4" wide stripe unit cost prorated for greater width. Example: 8" wide lines will be paid at 2 times the cost of a 4" wide line.
11. All quantities stated on the bid form are subject to adjustment as dictated by the City. For the purposes of this bid, all quantities are approximate and are supplied to allow comparison of bids. If application of such Unit Costs will cause substantial inequity to City or Contractor because of differences in the character or quantity of such unit items as originally contemplated, such unit prices shall be equitably adjusted. Substantial inequity shall be considered to exist only when the total amount of striping and marking performed in an assignment varies by more than 20 percent more or less than the amount estimated based on the Striping List . The annual amount of striping actually performed may vary from the bid form and no adjustment in unit costs shall be made for such annual variation.
14. The contractor shall remove poorly adhered existing markings and existing markings exceeding 0.25 inches thickness to a maximum thickness of 0.1inches. Removed material shall be collected and properly disposed. The method of disposal shall be included in the stormwater pollution prevention plan. Compensation for removal and disposal shall be included in the cost for Thermoplastic markings and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.
