Due to the number of stolen vehicle reports the Sedona Police Department receives, it is necessary that:

- I agree to assist in the prosecution of the theft of my vehicle. _____ (Initial)

Under ARS 13-2907.01, it is unlawful for a person to knowingly make to a law enforcement agency of either this state or a political subdivision of this state a false, fraudulent or unfounded report or statement or to knowingly misrepresent a fact for the purpose of interfering with the orderly operation of a law enforcement agency or misleading a peace officer. False Reporting to a law enforcement agency is a **class 1 misdemeanor** punishable up to six months in jail, \$2,500 fine and three years probation. Furthermore, under ARS 13-2204, it is unlawful for a person to knowingly destroy, remove, conceal, encumber, convert, sell, transfer, control, or otherwise deal with property subject to a security interest with the intent to hinder or prevent the enforcement of the interest. Defrauding Secured Creditors is a **class 6 felony** punishable up to 1.5 years in jail, and up to a \$150,000 fine.

IF THE AFFIDAVIT IS NOT TAKEN IN PERSON BY THE SEDONA POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE PERSON WHO ALLEGES THAT A THEFT OF MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION HAS OCCURRED SHALL MAIL OR DELIVER THE SIGNED AND NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT TO THE SEDONA POLICE DEPARTMENT WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS AFTER REPORTING THE THEFT. IF THE SEDONA POLICE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT RECEIVE THE SIGNED AND NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER THE INITIAL REPORT, THE VEHICLE INFORMATION SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE DATABASES OF THE NATIONAL CRIME INFORMATION CENTER AND THE ARIZONA CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM.
