BECOMING A LIFEGUARD: THE BASICS

If you are interested in becoming a lifeguard, lifeguard/Instructor or head lifeguard, complete the following steps:

1. Register and take the Lifeguard Certification Course, and/or Water Safety Instructor Training Course. See the schedule of classes included in this brochure.
2. Submit an application. First review of applicants will be March 5th; **Head Lifeguard positions will close on April 6th**. Applications may be submitted before required courses are completed; just indicate class dates.
3. Top qualifying candidates must be prepared to participate in an oral interview, lifeguarding skills test, and practical water skills evaluation test.
