

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEDONA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SEDONA HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT FINGERPRINTS TO THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR A CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK OF CURRENT OR PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES; AMENDING THE SEDONA CITY CODE, SECTION 2.90.040 (FINGERPRINT REQUIREMENTS); PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES OR CODE PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council to provide further clarity and ease of administration of fingerprints to the Department of Public Safety for the purposes of evaluating the fitness of prospective employees, contract employees, and volunteers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEDONA, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In General

The human resources department is authorized to receive, and such persons shall submit, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1750 and PL 92-544, fingerprints for state and federal criminal history record information for the purpose of evaluating the fitness of prospective employees, contract employees, or volunteers. The fingerprints received shall be submitted to the Arizona Department of Public Safety, and the Arizona Department of Public Safety may exchange this fingerprint data with the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Section 2. Amendment of Section 2.90.040 (FINGERPRINT REQUIREMENTS)

Section 2.90.040 of the Sedona City Code is hereby amended by incorporating by reference those changes set forth in that public record entitled "*2018 Amendments to the Sedona City Code (FINGERPRINT REQUIREMENTS)*" and established as a public record by Resolution No. 2018-07 as though said provisions are fully set forth herein.


Section 3. Savings Clause

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repeal

All other code provisions, ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict as of the effective date hereof.


