PUBLIC NOTICE PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING USE OF CDBG FUNDS

Notice is hereby given that the City of Sedona will hold a public hearing at Sedona City Hall in the Vultee Conference Room located at 102 Roadrunner Drive, Building #106, Sedona, Arizona, on **Thursday, November 29, 2018, at 4:00 p.m.** to gather citizen input on the use of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

The City of Sedona is expected to receive approximately \$330,000 in FY19 federal CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Regional Account. The City of Sedona may also apply for up to \$300,000 in FY19 CDBG funds from the State Special Projects (SSP) account. CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight, or address urgent need. Sample CDBG projects are:

- 1) Public infrastructure (e.g., water, wastewater, drainage improvements);
- 2) Community facilities (e.g., halfway houses, senior centers, food banks);
- 3) Housing (e.g., owner occupied housing rehabilitation, utility connections on private property, rental housing rehabilitation);
- 4) Public services (e.g., emergency assistance, purchasing a van to transport persons with disabilities, services for homeless persons);
- 5) Economic development (e.g., a loan to a business for job creation, micro-enterprise development, acquisition of land for an existing business expansion).
