SUMMARY STATEMENT

Background: On November 6, 2018, the City of Sedona held a General Election. A.R.S. § 16-643 requires that all election returns be made public by determining the vote for and against each measure appearing upon the ballot at the election. The General Election was for consideration of Proposition 446, a citizen initiative measure amending Title 3, Sedona City Code, by adding Chapter 3.25, related to adjustment of permanent base.

Unofficial final election results have been received from Coconino and Yavapai counties. Proposition 446 was defeated by a large margin with 1,981 (36.6%) "Yes" votes and 3,431 (63.4%) "No" votes. Sedona voter turnout for this General Election was 79.87%. The election results need to be read into the City's record to become official.

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEDONA, ARIZONA DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018.

WHEREAS, the City of Sedona, Arizona held a General Election on the 6th day of November, 2018 for consideration of Proposition 446; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the City Council as shown in the attached Exhibits A & B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sedona, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. That the total number of ballots cast at said Primary Election, as shown by the Election Summary Reports, was 5,949.

Section 2. That, due to the passage of consolidated election legislation, Coconino and Yavapai Counties are not able to provide the number of ballots to be verified or the number of ballots rejected at the municipal level.

Section 3. That the votes cast for Proposition 446, a citizen initiative measure amending Title 3, Sedona City Code, by adding Chapter 3.25, related to adjustment of permanent base, were as follows:

Section 4. That it is hereby found, determined and declared of record, that Proposition 446 was not approved by the electors of the City voting at said General Election.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
