By majority consensus, Council agreed:  • that the SCC&TB's FY20 budget as presented met the expectations approved during the January retreat  • to have the SCC&TB manage the Uptown restroom improvements project and include those costs in their budget  • that the SCC&TB contract should be modified according to the recommendations of the City Attorney and include:  o elimination of the requirement to fix the contract to 55% of bed tax collections but maintain reference to the 55% as a common industry standard  o a fixed number to be negotiated annually o a budget built from the ground up reflective of services needed each year  o annual financial audits  • to modify the policy portion of the ordinance language in 2013-07 as recommended by the City Attorney to allow for additional flexibility but consistent with the original spirit and intent of the ordinance.
