SUMMARY STATEMENT

<u>Background:</u> On August 4, 2020, the City of Sedona held a Primary Election. A.R.S. § 16-643 requires that all election returns be made public by determining the vote for each person voted for and the vote for and against each referred measure appearing upon the ballot at the election. The Primary Election was for the Mayoral seat for two years and three City Council seats for four-year terms. The City had no ballot measures on the August 4, 2020 Primary Election ballot.

Four candidates, Mayor and Councilor 4-year term (3 seats), received enough votes at the Primary Election to be elected without going forward to the General Election. These candidates will be issued Certificates of Election. In order for these election results to become official, they need to be read into the City's record. There will be no need to participate in the November 3rd General Election as all of the Council seats were filled in the Primary Election.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEDONA, ARIZONA DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 4, 2020.

WHEREAS, the City of Sedona, Arizona held a Primary Election on the 4th day of August, 2020 for the nomination/election of a Mayor for a two-year term and three (3) Councilors for four-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the City Council as shown in the attached Exhibits A & B.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sedona, Arizona, as follows:
