SPECIAL BUSINESS	AB 2691	Discussion/possible direction regarding the draft Uptown Community Focus Area (CFA) Plan.	By majority consensus, Council agreed that changes should be made to the Uptown CFA Plan Draft consistent with discussion today, including the following: • Reorganizing the Circulation Strategies section and adding a "Transit" subheading which reads, "Future implementation of a transit system is anticipated. The systems goal is to reduce traffic and provide alternatives for efficient and sustainable movement throughout Uptown and the City." • Making pedestrian bridge plural and using the word "consider developing" instead of just "develop". • Keeping the existing sidewalk on the highway near the proposed Vista Trail scenic path. • Explaining more thoroughly that the photos included in the plan are just examples and not actual proposals/projects. • Using the word "protect" in place of "preserve" when referring to Oak Creek Conservation. • Encouraging additional parking within the Creekside Resort area as stated in the proposed language. • Allowing flexibility on height only when it meets the goals of the CFA, and add protection of view shed as a stated CFA goal.
