# Status Update

- Last presentation to Council was November 23 (21 days ago)
- Yavapai and Coconino counties both remain categorized as high transmission
- Staff participates in Yavapai and Coconino county health update calls
  - Next Yavapai County meeting tentatively scheduled for January
  - Next Coconino County meeting scheduled for December 20
- The first Arizona case involving the omicron variant was identified in Yavapai County December 8
- CDC expands COVID-19 booster authorization to 16- and 17-year-olds (Pfizer-BioNTech only)



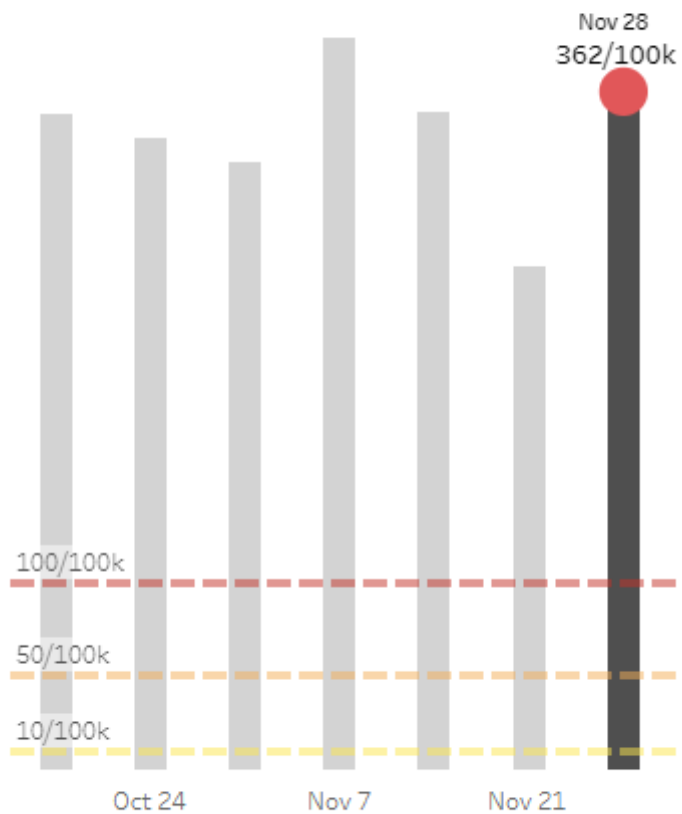

Showing data for **Coconino County**

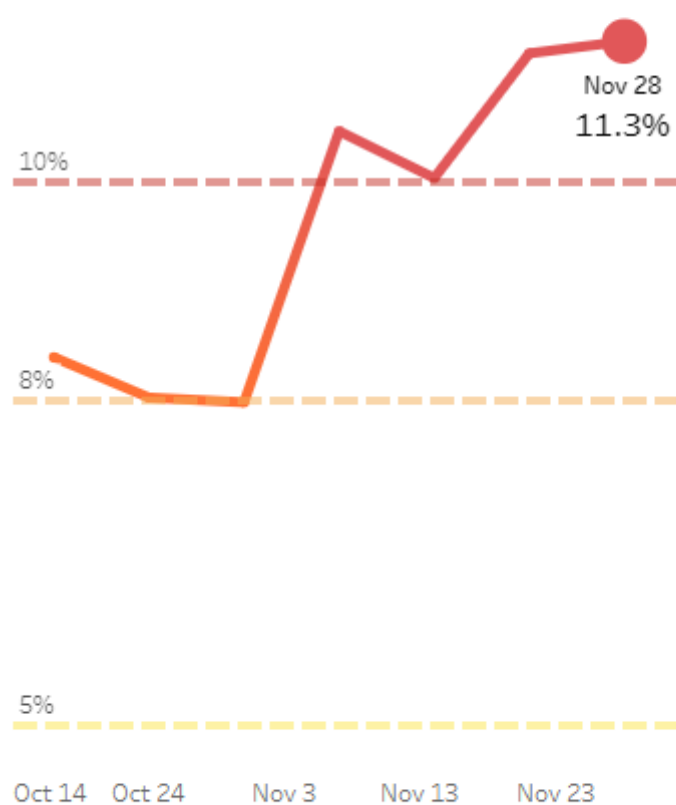
**High Transmission**

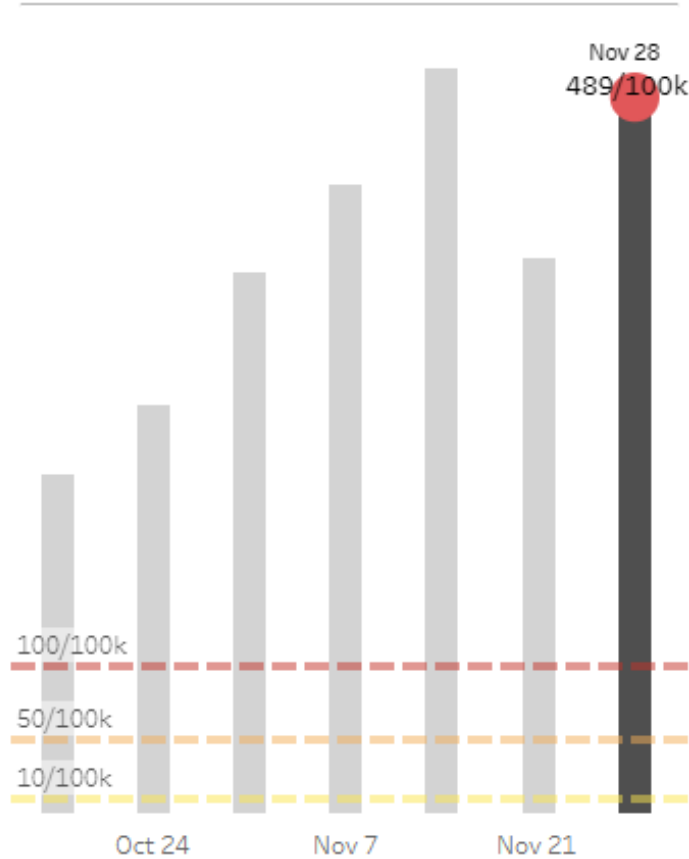

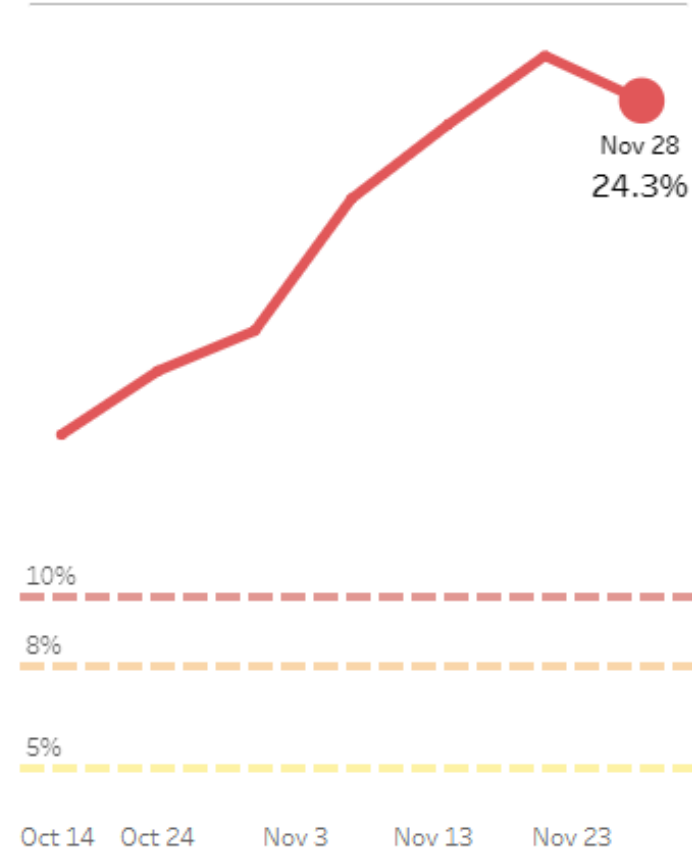
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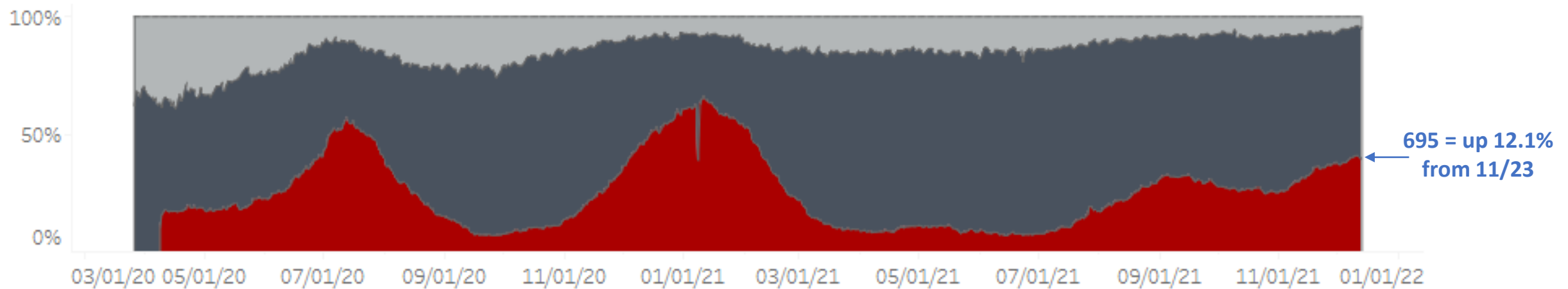

# Number of Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Beds

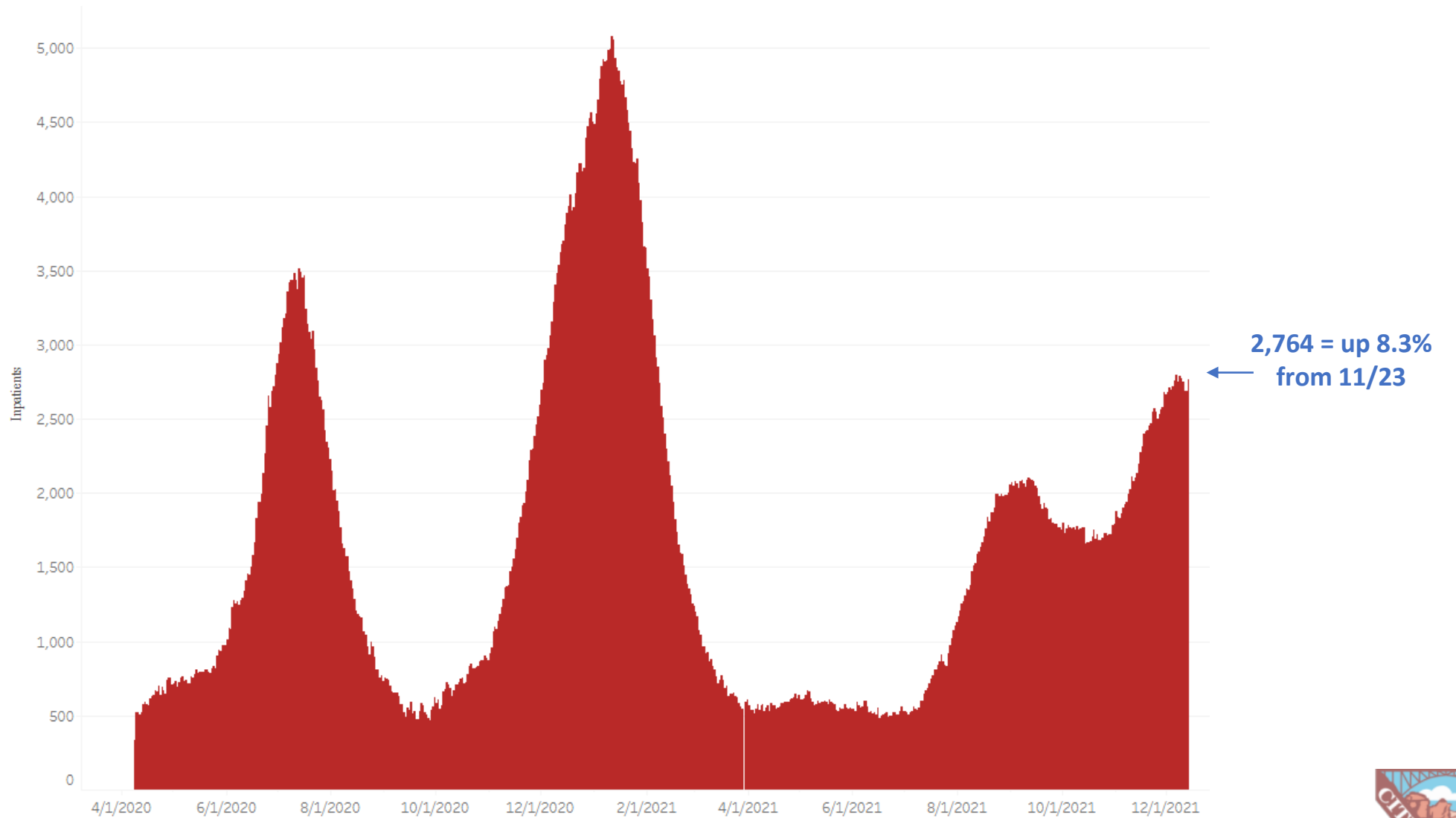

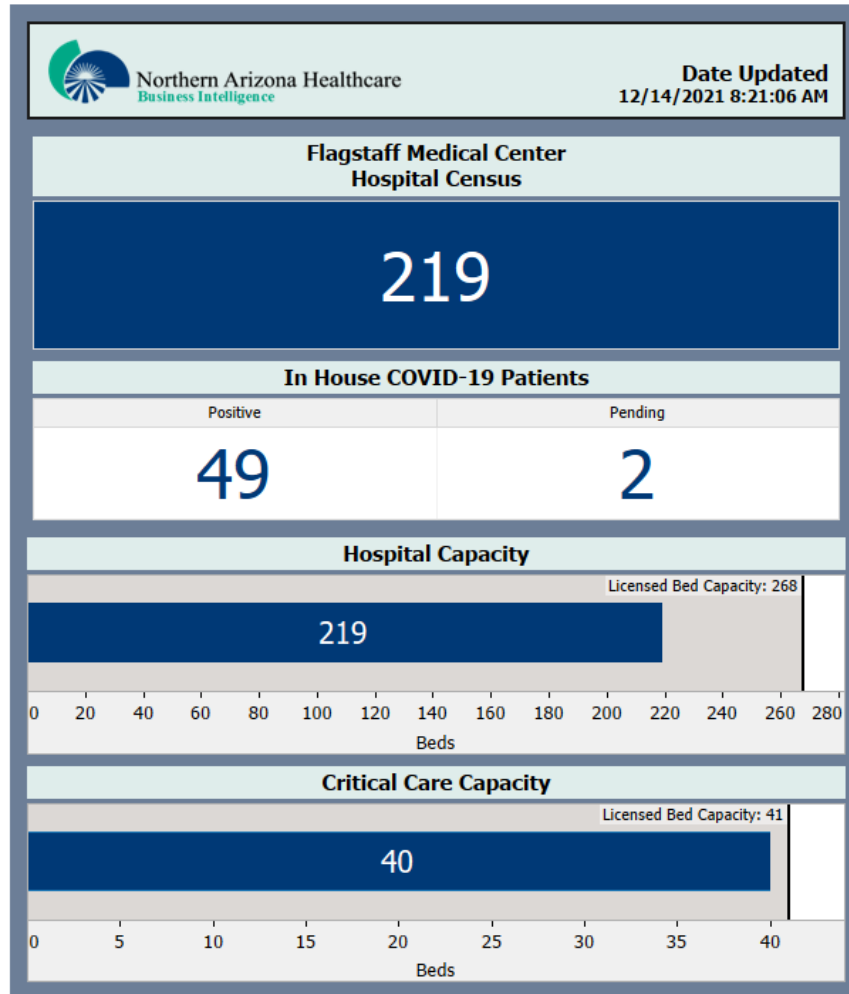

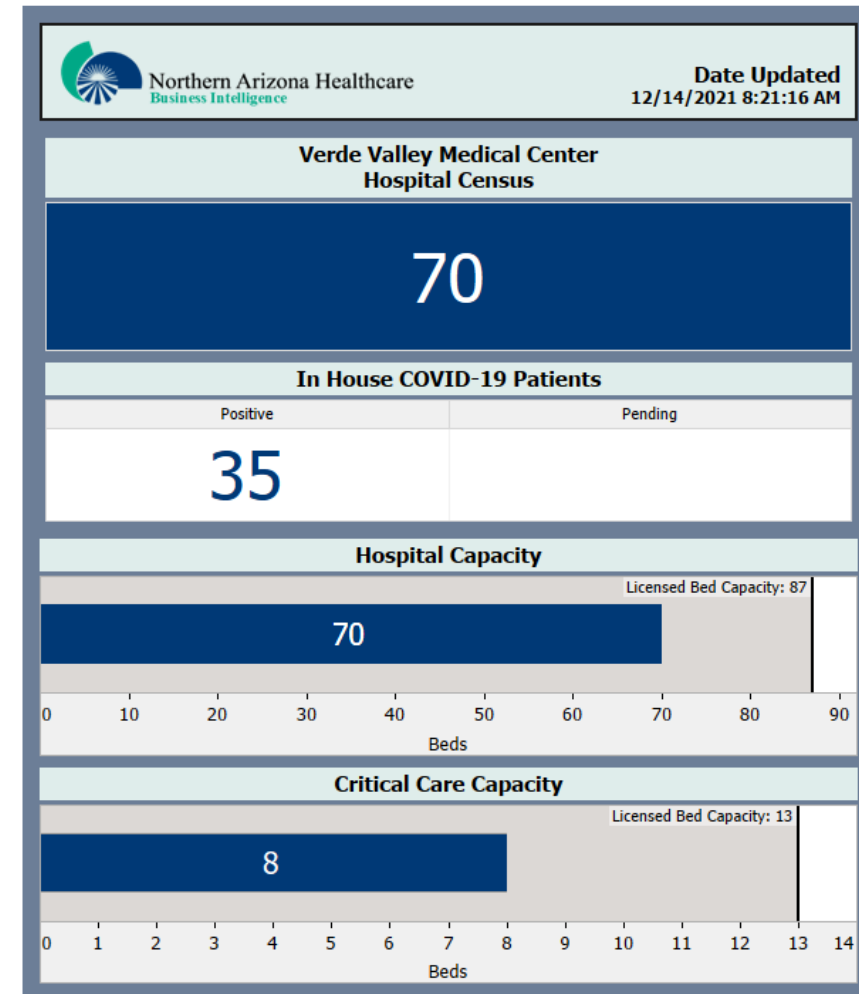
# Hospital Data

- **Flagstaff:** In House COVID-19 as of 12/14: 49 – up from 39 on 11/23 (+25.6%)
- **VVMC:** In House COVID-19 as of 12/14: 35 – up from 26 on 11/23 (+34.6%)

# Yavapai and Coconino County Vaccinations

## Statewide:

- 63.8% of population has had at least 1 dose of vaccine (*up from 61.6% on 11/23*)
- 9.4 million doses administered (*up from 8.81 million on 11/23*)
- 67.9% of *eligible people* vaccinated (age 5 and older\*\*) (*up from 65.6% on 11/23*)

## Yavapai:

- 50.0% of total population has had at least 1 dose of vaccine (116,291) (*up from 48.8% on 11/23*)
- 42.3% of total population\* has been fully-vaccinated (98,258) (*up from 41.5% on 11/23*)
- 52.2% of *eligible people* vaccinated (age 5 and older\*\*) (*up from 50.9% on 11/23*)

## Coconino:

- 63.6% of total population has had at least 1 dose of vaccine (93,664) (*up from 61.9% on 11/23*)
- 55.3% of total population\* has been fully-vaccinated (81,378) (*up from 54.6% on 11/23*)
- 67.3% of *eligible people* vaccinated (age 5 and older\*\*) (*up from 65.5% on 11/23*)
