Complete applications will contain the following and must be submitted by February 6, 2022:

- 1. Completed Sedona Food Truck Festival Application
- 2. Sedona Business License (or application to purchase Sedona Special Event Business License. Fee will be collected once initial application is approved.)
- 3. Copy of <u>Yavapai County Special Event Food Vendor License</u> (or agreement to purchase, once initial application is approved)
- 4. Copy of Driver's License
- 5. Copy of Most Current Health Inspection
- 6. Certificate of Insurance with Endorsement Listing City of Sedona as Additionally Insured
- 7. Truck or Trailer Site Plan and Pictures
- 8. Menu Items and Prices

Approved applicants will be notified by email by February 14, and asked to provide the following by their respective deadlines in order to remain eligible to participate in the event:

- 1. Copy of Yavapai County Special Event Food Vendor License (or copy of new application, if not current. New applications must be submitted to Yavapai County no later than March 3, 2022)
- 2. Payment of City of Sedona application fee(s). \$50 Non-refundable application fee; \$10 Sedona Special Event Business License (If Applicable.) Payment must be submitted by February 25, 2022.
