### Lifeguard Training

The StarGuard courses are blended-learning and require participants to complete approximately 8 hours of online training prior to the first day of class.

Weekend training course offered in Late April—Early May

The SAI StarGuard Training course is offered to those interested in becoming a certified lifeguard. This course will certify the participant in StarGuard Lifeguard Training and Basic First Aid and CPR/AED for the Professional. Participants will receive a StarGuard Lifeguard training manual and personal mask.

#### PREREQUISITES:

Must be 15 years old by the last day of course taken. Swim 100 yds head up non-stop (50 yds with guard tube). Retrieve a 10 lb. weight from a maximum depth of 7' water. Tread water for one minute without use of hands. Completion of online training prior to first day of class.

### **Swim Instructor Training**

Do you love to teach? Have a passion for developing aquatic skills and water safety practices? Become a Starfish Swim Instructor! Apply and attend one our courses offered: Course Dates for Starfish Swim Instructor: TBD—Mid to late May.

This course is designed to instruct participants in the skills & techniques required to teach the fundamentals of swimming and water safety. Anyone interested in teaching swimming lessons with the City of Sedona must have a Starfish Swimming Instructor certification. After successfully completing the course, participants will be certified to teach swim lessons as a Starfish Swim Instructor.

Must be 16 years old by the last day of course taken
