

SR179 Sewer Main Replacement: Phase 2

Welcome to the City of Sedona SR179 Sewer Main Replacement: Phase 2 eNews. Businesses and residents are reminded to call the **Project Hotline at (928) 852-4164** to speak to a project team member with any questions or concerns. Please note that in the event of inclement weather the work schedule may be altered or suspended without notice.

Sewer work is scheduled to be complete in the coming weeks, with final paving happening later in the spring when temperatures allow.

The City of Sedona and their contractor, Standard Construction Company, are working on the second, and final, phase of the SR179 Sewer Main Replacement Project. The project consists of the removal and replacement of approximately 365 feet of sewer main along SR179, from the stopping point of Phase 1 through the Schnebly Hill Roundabout. In addition to this work, approximately 400 feet of sewer main will be upgraded under the pedestrian bridge crossing Oak Creek adjacent to SR179.

SEWER MAIN REPAIR TO CONTINUE NEAR TLAQUEPAQUE NORTH

Crews will continue repairing the damaged sewer main and manholes in front of Tlaquepaque North, as highlighted in the map below. Following sewer repair, crews will tie-in the new sewer main into the City's existing system.

Please be aware of the following impacts:

Monday, February 28 through Thursday, March 3, 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.

The contractor will coordinate with local businesses to ensure access is continuously provided, however, sidewalk and driveway closures may occur. Sewer bypass pipe will be laid across the pedestrian bridge crossing Oak Creek. The bridge will remain open, however, please be aware of construction equipment and follow the marked signage to get to your destination.

Sunday, February 27, through Thursday, March 3, 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.

To minimize impacts to local businesses and the traveling public, night work will be necessary to complete this work. A pilot car operation will be in place to keep traffic moving despite full lane closures. Please allow for extra time to get through the area and follow all marked signage.

CONCRETE WORK ONGOING

Crews will continue installing new sidewalk, driveway entrances and curb and gutter where it was disturbed throughout the project corridor. In addition to this work, crews will be restoring landscape to it's preconstruction condition.

Please be aware of the following impacts:

Monday, February 28 through Thursday, March 3, 7 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Please be aware of lane and sidewalk closures, flagging operations, reduced speeds and construction equipment along the project corridor. Access to businesses and residents will be provided at all times, however, temporary driveway closures will be necessary. The contractor will coordinate with local businesses to ensure access is continuously provided.

The City is dedicated to keeping residents, businesses, and visitors informed of potential impacts throughout the project.

Both the City and contractor would like to assure the local community that precautionary measures are in place to prevent impacts to Oak Creek, and to minimize impacts to local businesses and the traveling public.

Night work will be scheduled and is necessary to complete a portion of this project. A pilot car operation will be in place during night work to keep traffic moving, despite lane closures. Please allow for extra time to get through this area and follow all marked signage.


