COUNCIL ATTENDANCE: All present.

PUBLIC FORUM: Donna Joy Varney, Sedona, voiced concerns about the City's relationship with the Sedona Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau (SCC&TB) and the SCC&TB use of City funds. Gayle Baingo, Sedona, voiced concerns about the Citizen's Engagement Program, she believes the participants are hand-picked. Charles Tyler, Sedona, voiced concerns with the Transit Program and believes the City's contract process is not transparent, he stated the citizen's needs and desires are not considered and believes the commercial interest of the public has been violated. Alissa Tyler, Sedona, voiced concerns with Planning and Zoning and believes the public does not have input into matters such as building height restrictions and shared use paths, she stated her commercial rights have been violated. Teresa Vos, Sedona, stated the library services and other city services would not be negatively impacted if the Home Rule budget option expires. She said the Sedona Library is supported by Yavapai County tax dollars \$1M from Yavapai County property tax funds and receives other donations. She said with the state baseline budget rule is set to protect people from the mismanagement of City funds.
