

Juniper Trail Sewer Extension

FY22 CIP Update



In 2011, in conjunction with the SR179 Realignment Project, an 8-inch dryline sewer was installed for future use. In order to make the dryline active, approximately 200 linear feet of sewer will be installed in Juniper Trail to tie the dryline into the active collection system. The extension will allow for the potential connection of up to 31 properties, 9 of which are undeveloped.

<u>Status</u>: Shephard-Wesnitzer, Inc. has completed the design of the new sewer main. A construction contract with KEAR Civil Corporation is scheduled for approval at the July 12, 2022 City Council meeting. Construction on the project will begin mid-July and will take approximately 3 months to complete.
