The residents of this neighborhood have requested sidewalks and paths for safe pedestrian travel. The Council discussed this project at the retreat as an important project to continue to move ahead as a priority.

Community Outreach meeting is scheduled for October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the Sedona Library on White Bear Road. Different options will be presented to the attendees/residents and participants will be asked to identify their preferred option.

The Transportation Master Plan, Strategy 11, Walking and Bicycling Facilities, indicates that these improvements collectively encourage use of alternative modes of travel in Sedona, and support a park-ounce cultures where visitors and residents are encouraged to leave their vehicles at their place of lodging/residence. To have a measurable impact on traffic congestion, shared-use path connections will be required.

This project would provide a shared-use pathway connection from Thunder Mountain Road to SR 89A. This will also provide a multimodal connection to businesses for the residents of this neighborhood.
