This Addendum clarifies the following:

QUESTIONS

1. Submitted question:

QUESTION: Does the City have specific water quality or air quality pollutants of concern for assessing/monitoring as part of this study?

RESPONSE: Water Quality – The City would like to determine if nearby water resources (if any) are, in general, being polluted. The City would like the successful firm to conduct water testing and deliver a report on what pollutants are present for further analysis.

Air Quality – The primary pollutant for this project is particulate matter (dust).

2. Submitted question:

QUESTION: Besides the obvious primary pollutant of concern, particulate matter, for which air pollutants does the City desire monitoring be performed?

RESPONSE: If possible and appropriate for this assessment, monitoring for exhaust pollutants resulting from the operation of off highway vehicles may be desirable.

It is the intention of the City to collaborate with the successful firm to finalize the scope of the assessment to determine the appropriate types of monitoring for this project.

3. Submitted question:

QUESTION: Would the 5 locations be inclusive of upwind monitoring site(s)? Or in addition?

RESPONSE: Locations to be monitored are still to be determined. The successful firm is invited to recommend locations for monitoring based on a preliminary list of sites; however, the final list of locations will be determined once project planning with the successful firm begins.
