Food Service Ware Recommendations & Restrictions

Our region is pursuing sustainable practices to protect our environment and livability, so we want to minimize waste as much as possible at our special events. We do our part by providing recycling and composting service at all major city-hosted events. We encourage all vendors to be part of the solution by following the below guidelines.

Mobile food vendors participating in City of Sedona special events should avoid Styrofoam and other hard-to-recycle materials, aim to minimize leftovers and food waste, and serve on truly compostable materials or easily recycled containers.



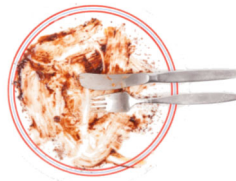
Compostable and Recyclable Items

Compostable products made of pulp or paper without a polymer, bio-polymer or bioplastic coating or wooden cutlery. Recyclable products include recycled content #5 plasticware and #5 recyclable plastic cups.



Items to Throw In the Trash

Heavily food-soiled items, plastic bags, plastic wraps, meat and dairy should be thrown in the trash to avoid recycling contamination.



Items to Avoid at City of Sedona Special Events

Plastic water bottle sales and expanded polystyrene foam containers are discouraged at City of Sedona special events.
