



\$ FY23 Project Budget: \$1,356,900

This project consists of providing enhanced transit from the Village of Oak Creek, continuing north on SR 179 and SR 89A into Oak Creek Canyon. It includes periodic stops, park and ride lots, and trailhead service. Planning for the project included representatives from City staff, ADOT, US Forest Service, AZ State Parks, Coconino County, Verde Shuttle, Sedona Fire District, and the Sedona Chamber of Commerce. The first step will be implementation of Phase 1, which extends the core routes and includes a service to specific trailheads.

Status: The trailhead shuttle service began on March 24, 2022, providing service from two park & ride locations (Posse Grounds Park & 1294 SR-179) to Cathedral Rock, Dry Creek Vista, Little Horse, and Soldiers Pass trailheads. In June, Mescal Trailhead was added. Between March 24th and October 31st the trailhead shuttles logged **166,233** passenger boardings, which has exceeded ridership expectations. The launch of the demand response ([Sedona Shuttle Connect](#)) service is postponed until at least the second quarter of 2023 due to on-going supply chain issues causing delays with the vehicle manufacturers. Preliminary site selection and environmental studies have been completed for the construction of a transit maintenance and operations facility and concept design has begun for the mobility hub.
