

**Action Minutes

**1. CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL**

Chair Unger called the site visit to order at 56 Lynx Dr. at **2:06 p.m.** and requested roll call.

**a. 56 Lynx Dr, Sedona, aka The Kiva House**

Commissioners noted the unique architectural style as we walked the site. All commissioners noted the architectural style was reminiscent of Frank Lloyd Wright. The homeowner showed us the interior and exterior of the home. The exterior of the house has been slightly modified from the original build. No Action was taken.

Commissioners walked the site at Tlaquepaque Plaza Arts and Shopping Village. They examined the tower and the chapel. Commissioner Fiene noted that the chapel at Tlaquepaque has a real sense of place. Chair Unger noted that the chapel would be a good project for HPC to focus on next. No action was taken.
