	Assist with checking-in parade participants, prompting participants at parade start, set-

10am – 12pm	EQUESTRIAN CLEAN UP – 4-6 Volunteers Needed
Ivaiii – Izpiii	Walk parade route and assist with clean-up after horse entries. Equipment (shovels,
	wheel barrows, etc.) will be supplied.
	Requires the ability to walk long distance and be on foot for an extended period of time.
10am – 12pm	BANNERS – 12 Volunteers Needed
•	Walk parade route and assist with carrying parade banners. Requires the ability to walk
	long distance and be on foot for an extended period of time.
10am - 12:30pm	PARADE PACE SETTERS – 2 Volunteers Needed
	Assist with setting and keeping parade pace and managing parade entrants along route.
	Volunteer will be stationed on parade route and has option to stand/sit during parade.
	Requires the ability to communicate loudly and clearly.
