We are seeking volunteers for the following assignments:

TIME COMMITMENT	VOLUNTEER ASSIGNMENT
7am – 10am	SHUTTLE SERVICE PARKING LOT ATTENDANT – 2 Volunteers Needed Assist parade participants with parking and directing to shuttle pick-up location. Requires the ability to walk and be on foot for an extended period of time.
7am – 1pm	DIGNITARY HOSTS – 3 Volunteers Needed Assist with greeting and checking-in parade dignitaries and judges, direct/coordinate dignitaries to shuttle service, provide support to judges and dignitaries, set-up/break down of dignitary/judge station. Requires the ability to walk and be on foot for an extended period of time.
7:30am – 12pm	PARADE CHECK-IN: VEHICLES/FLOATS – 2 Volunteers Needed Assist with checking-in parade participants, prompting participants at parade start, set-up/break down of station. Requires the ability to walk and be on foot for an extended period of time.
7:30am – 12pm	PARADE CHECK-IN: WALKERS – 2 Volunteers Needed Assist with checking-in parade participants, prompting participants at parade start, set-up/break down of station. Requires the ability to walk and be on foot for an extended period of time.
7:30am – 12pm	PARADE CHECK-IN: EQUESTRIANS – 1-2 Volunteers Needed Assist with checking-in parade participants, prompting participants at parade start, set-up/break down of station. Requires the ability to walk and be on foot for an extended period of time.
10am – 12pm	EQUESTRIAN CLEAN UP – 4-6 Volunteers Needed Walk parade route and assist with clean-up after horse entries. Equipment (shovels, wheel barrows, etc.) will be supplied. Requires the ability to walk long distance and be on foot for an extended period of time.
10am – 12pm	BANNERS – 12 Volunteers Needed Walk parade route and assist with carrying parade banners. Requires the ability to walk long distance and be on foot for an extended period of time.
10am – 12:30pm	PARADE PACE SETTERS – 2 Volunteers Needed Assist with setting and keeping parade pace and managing parade entrants along route. Volunteer will be stationed on parade route and has option to stand/sit during parade. Requires the ability to communicate loudly and clearly.
