

The SAI StarGuard Training course is offered to those interested in becoming a certified lifeguard. The courses are blended-learning and participants will complete approximately 6 hours of online training prior to the first day of class.

Class certification cost: \$50

Lifeguarding courses offered for first time certifications and renewals in March and May.

Course #1: March 14, 15, & 16 11am - 4:30pm

Course #2: May Weekend (TBA)

These courses will certify the participant in StarGuard Lifeguard Training and American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI) Basic First Aid and CPR/AED for the Professional. Participants will receive a StarGuard Lifeguard training manual and personal mask kit.

PREREQUISITES:

- Swim 100 yds head up, non-stop (50 yds with guard tube)
- Retrieve a 10 lb. weight from a depth of 7 feet of water
- Tread water without hands for 1 minute
- Completion of online training prior to first day of class
- Must be 15 years old by the last day of course

Registration is required for all courses. Deadline to register is 7 days prior to course start date. Attendance to all class dates is mandatory.



STARFISH SWIM INSTRUCTOR

Do you love to teach? Do you have a passion for developing lifetime aquatic skills? Become a Starfish Swim Instructor!

Course Dates for Starfish Swim Instructor: TBD — Mid to late May

This course is designed to instruct participants in the skills and techniques required to teach the fundamentals of swimming and water safety. Anyone interested in teaching swimming lessons with the City of Sedona must have a Starfish Swimming Instructor certification.

After successfully completing the course, passing a written test, and completing four teach backs, participants will be certified to teach swim lessons as a Starfish Swim Instructor.
