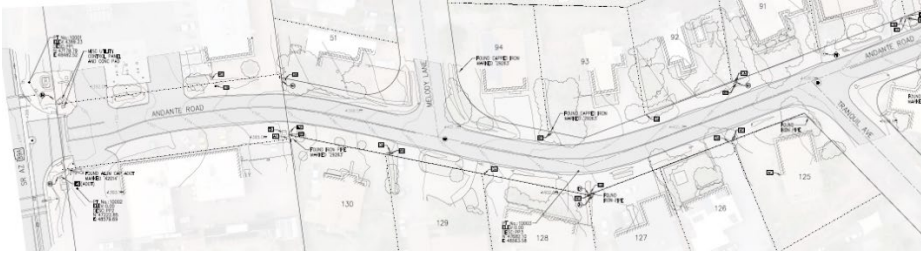

The residents of this neighborhood have requested sidewalks and paths for safe pedestrian travel. The Council discussed this project at the retreat as an important project to continue to move ahead as a priority.

Community Outreach meeting occurred in December, 2022 at the Sedona Public Library on White Bear Road. Different options were presented to the attendees/residents and participants were asked to identify their preferred option. Bi-lingual door hangers were placed to notify residents of the outreach meeting as well as a letter sent out. Results of outreach showed Andante as the preferred location of the SUP. Consultant was hired to gather topographic information and evaluate whether the east or west side would be best for the path placement. Speed tables will also be evaluated. Federal RAISE Grant application package has been submitted.

This project would provide a shared-use pathway connection from Thunder Mountain Road to SR 89A. This will also provide a multimodal connection to businesses for the residents of this neighborhood.
