FY23 CIP Update



Traffic congestion during the peak visitor season continues to be the number one complaint by city residents. Add to that the overflow of trailhead parking into some of the city's neighborhoods and surface streets, and it becomes clear that this issue is adversely affecting public safety as well as the quality of life of many of Sedona's residents.

To alleviate traffic congestion, the trailhead shuttle system became operational in March 2022. At the subject Park & Ride facility on Bowstring Drive, the existing leased parking lot is in the process of being purchased from the Church of the Red Rocks.

A conceptual design was completed last year by Kimley-Horn design consultants. This described the proposed provision of permanent public restrooms, shade structures and other amenities to enhance the Sedona Shuttle experience.

Final design consultants are being commissioned for further assessment of the facility to make it more suitable for shuttle pickup services.
