




The USFS wishes to renew the agreement with the City of Sedona that allows for work of mutual benefit. The current agreement expires on October 23, 2023.



Future work


- Maintenance of non-motorized trails in and around the Sedona City limits
- Management of a trail maintenance volunteer program, and supervision of volunteer trail patrollers and ambassadors.







Cathedral Rock Renewal Project








Rabbit Ears and Little Rock Realignments









Western Gateway Trail System













These crews are funded by grants prepared by district staff and local partners. They provide vital assistance to our construction and maintenance projects and offer experience and training in recreation based public land management.
