This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Request for Proposals documents to the same extent as if it were originally included therein. The following clarifications shall be made to the Request for Proposals and shall become a part of, and attached to, the Request for Proposals documents.

This addendum is issued in response to questions received from prospective Respondents.

Questions and Answers

1. Why can the City not provide specific quantities of debris to be picked up and request pricing based on that?

Answer: The City cannot provide a specified quantity of debris because the program is optional for City residents and while there is a maximum amount of debris allowed per resident, it is not feasible to predict the amount of debris that will ultimately be collected during execution of services.

2. Is the yard waste already out on the curbside? When will it be?

Answer: No, the yard waste is not currently curbside. The City will be sending out a communication to residents indicating when each zone will be serviced. Residents will then be able to stage their debris for pick up.

3. How will the City ensure that residents don't continue to put out new debris?

Answer: Once the collection date for each zone has been passed, no further debris will be collected by the City. Residents will be required to put debris out the day before collection begins, for each zone, by 4:00 p.m. The City will drive through each zone on the first day of the pickup.

4. How will the City ensure that prohibited items are not included in debris piles?

Answer: The Contractor shall not collect any non-conforming debris that is left curbside. The City will also be sending out educational information with notice of when residents will need to have their debris piles staged.

5. Can the City clarify what are the working hours for crews?

Answer: Working hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. as specified in Part III – E.3. of the RFP document.

6. Will the City consider other ways to compensate the awarded contractor instead of day rates?

Answer: No. The City will continue with the pricing and payment schedule contained in Part III – E and Part III – F of the RFP.
