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Sedona in Motion 11S - Little Horse Shared-Use Path

FY25 CIP UPDATE



This is a part of the ST&PS system and recommended in the updated Trails and Pathways Master Plan. Completing this segment would provide a safe multimodal facility from the Little Horse Trailhead Parking Lot to existing sidewalk. This is an area that experiences high volumes of pedestrian and bicycle use.

ADOT has right-of-way that this shated-use pathway would be within. During the construction of the split lanes of State Route 179, a NEPA Clearance was completed. USFS is requiring an updated clearance. City Staff has met with USFS Staff and together are working to improve this carsonite marked social trail into a more weather resilient, wider pathway.

The shared-use path will be constructed using stabilized decomposed granite with some sections possibly paving and/or concrete installation. This project will allow safer pedestrian access along this route and will continue to make Sedona a more walkable and bikeable community.
