The first event is our Community Police Academy. The purpose of the Community Police Academy is to engage our community and bring deeper understanding about policing efforts in Sedona. And the benefits are not only to share information with the participants, but for our Police Department staff to connect with residents in a casual setting, so that we can take the opportunity for us all to come together, learn from each other and continue to build our sense of community.
