

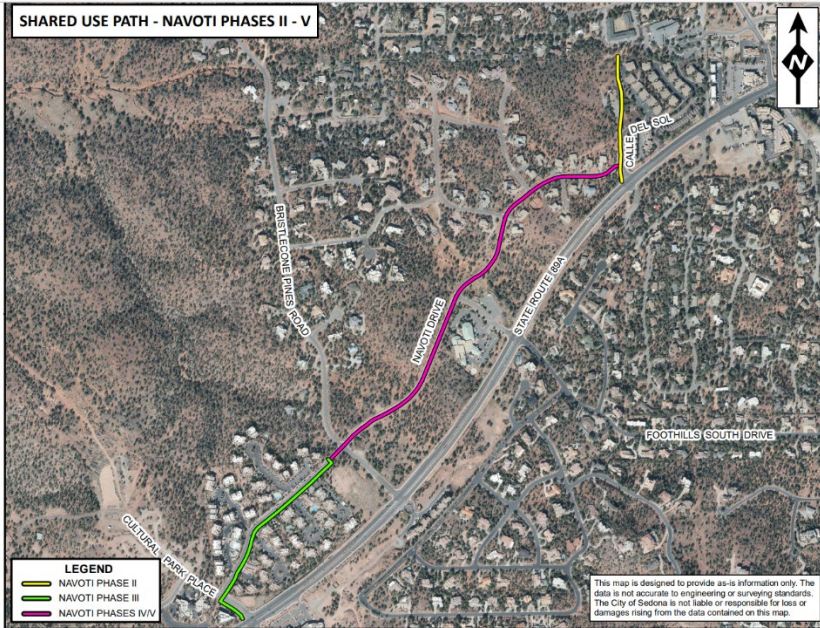

FY25 CIP UPDATE

This is a part of the ST&PS system and is recommended in the updated Trails and Pathways Master Plan. Completing this segment would provide a safe multimodal facility alternative to traveling on 89A. The State Route 89A experiences high vehicle volumes and is not a bike-ped experience that encourages alternative modes of travel in Sedona.

The shared-use pathway would connect the west State Route 89A Park & Ride to the Dry Creek Road Pathway. This is just short of a mile of new pathway. This parallel route will give users a great experience off of ST89A.

As part of the Sedona Trails & Pathways System (ST&PS), the City of Sedona is currently completing the Dry Creek Road Pathway. The city will begin the feasibility phase on this pathway with an engineer yet to be awarded the design contract.

The shared-use path will be constructed with stabilized decomposed granite with some sections to be colored concrete. This project will continue to make Sedona a more walkable and bikeable community.
