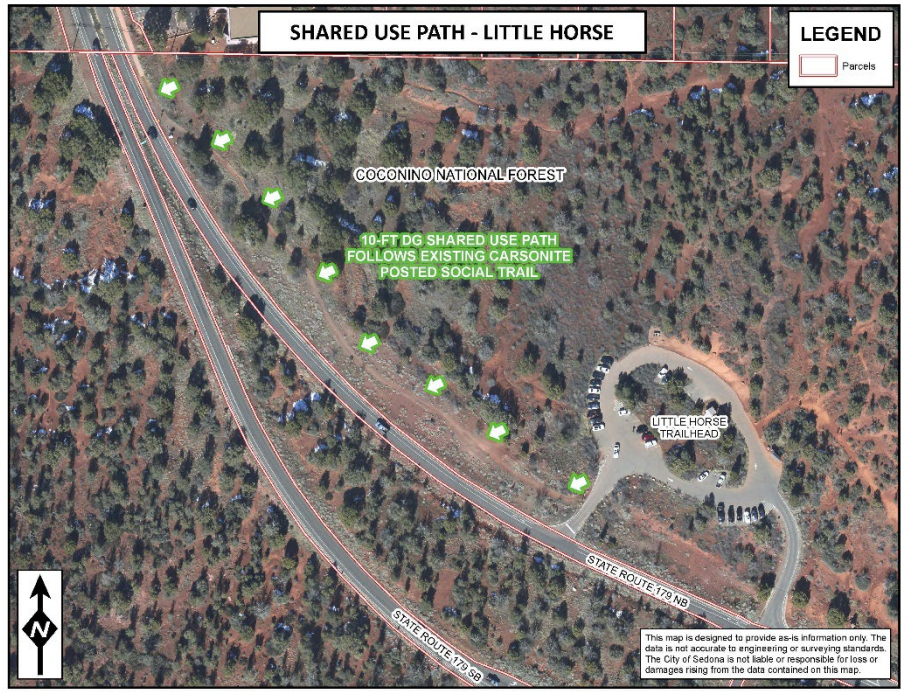

FY25 CIP UPDATE

This is a part of the ST&PS system and recommended in the updated Trails and Pathways Master Plan. Completing this segment would provide a safe multimodal facility from the Little Horse Trailhead Parking Lot to existing sidewalk. This is an area that experiences high volumes of pedestrian and bicycle use.

ADOT has right-of-way that this shared-use pathway would be within. During the construction of the split lanes of State Route 179, a NEPA clearance was completed. USFS is reviewing whether an updated clearance will be needed. City Staff has met with USFS Staff and together are working to improve this carsonite marked social trail into a more weather resilient, wider pathway.

The shared-use path will be constructed using stabilized decomposed granite with some sections possibly paving and/or concrete installation. This project will allow safer pedestrian access along this route and will continue to make Sedona a more walkable and bikeable community.
