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

SUBJECT Request to update consolidated fee schedule to include Annual Special Event, Business Licenses

The Sedona City Clerks' Office currently charges \$70.00 for a new regular business license application, \$35 for an annual renewal of a regular business license and \$10 for each special event, business license.

Business - Per Sedona City Code, "Business" means all activities or acts, personal or corporate, engaged in by any person or entity (or agent or employee of such person or entity) conducted for the purpose of apparent gain, benefit, or advantage, either direct or indirect, but not casual activities or sales. The term "business" shall include any trade, business, game, amusement, profession or occupation."

Special Event Business License – Per Sedona City Code, "Special Event Business License" Application for a temporary special event business license shall be made to the city no later than 5:00 p.m. three business days prior to the special event on forms made available by the city."

Historically, the Clerk's Office has issued regular business licenses to businesses located outside of city limits that participate in several special events throughout the calendar year. Several events being 7 or more events in a calendar year. This simplified the process for applicants by allowing them to renewal annually for a flat fee, instead of submitting several applications throughout the year. These businesses would list the location of the special event as the business' physical location. This process would streamline the application process.

One concern with the current process is that it skews our statistics when running reports using our business license software, (Civic Review). There is currently no differentiation between a regular local business and a business located outside of city limits participating in several special events annually.

By creating a separate application with a separate fee of \$70.00, applicants can apply for an "Annual Special Event" business license every calendar year. An application designated to an "Annual Special Event" business license, will allow staff to generate reports and isolate the two types of business license for accurate data.

An "Annual Special Event" business licenses can be applied for annually for a \$70.00 fee which is consistent with the new business license application fee of \$70.00.

There are currently approximately 40 businesses interested in an "Annual Special Event" business license out of approximately 485 "Special Event" business licenses. Of those businesses, the majority participate in Farmer's Markets and Art shows. These are continuous events that occur on weekends a few months out of the year. With an "Annual Special Event" business license, businesses can attend these events without putting additional strain on staff with repetitive applications to process weekly. The current process with only one type of special event business license is not advantageous to staff as it creates redundant effort.

I reviewed the websites of similar nearby cities, (Flagstaff, Cottonwood, Camp Verde and Payson) and did not find a similar type of annual special event business license application to compare our process with.

Aside from the addition of a new fee, we also need to add two established fees to the consolidated fee schedule. We currently have language in our city code, for an additional business license fee. Per Sedona City Code, 5.05.030, Issuance of Business license. "Every application shall be accompanied by the nonrefundable business license fee, as listed in the city fee schedule for the first business and \$5.00 for each additional business owned and operated by the same person or entity in a single location." This \$5.00 fee is currently not listed on the consolidated fee schedule.

There is a statutory rate for Bingo License fees that also needs to be added to the consolidated fee schedule. Per Arizona Revised Statute Title 5-414, a Bingo License has the following classifications and fees. Class A, \$5, class B, \$25 and class C, \$50.
